Black homes in philly & upstate n.y. gettin bombed up. sustas gettin raped (Jo Ann Little in n. carolina). i see to the sides to it, though. one, its a good thing cause it'll serve to heightened contradictions between the Black & 3rd World Colonies ^{-AND-} ~~with~~ babylon. two, it can be played up to look like a war between right-wingers & left-radicals as there doin in argentina now.

we gotta search fo' the right ways to show the people that we ain't about down the liberation for them but with them! we aint here to give 'em nothin - but to show 'em how to get, or better, win the power to make change. and if we don't stop talkin bout "analyze" & get down on it, we gonna get our feelings hurt (by taken things fo' granted!). like the Tupamaros say "we cannot work without plans anymore" & our work plans must be done with meticulous military care taken in all aspects of the struggle!
