2 copies of 37/m.y. file

Foundation: can only give \$ to tax-exempt, non-profit entity
(Internal Revenue Code)

Fund: can give \$ anywhere it wants
Universalist Church, for example

Foundation: 501C3 ~~sponsor~~, number
~~Form not for profit~~

Form a "not-for-profit Corp." - justify use of #
\$50 filing with state - can't take off income tax

Alternative: 501C3 Sponsor - like CAP STREET, California
or I.F.C.O.

\$ solicited goes 1st thru Sponsor
They take out a % for pay & forward rest to group
Once or twice a year, a report on \$ raised/used.

Relatively simple to implement.

Not-for-profit corp formation - 1st step regardless
of foundation, fund, sponsor.

Certain things a Corp. can't have in name
due to legalities & plagiarism

Bob willing to advise (w/others); do "not-for-profit" legal work,
but not IRS move (not his field of expertise), tho' willing

to act as intermediary between us and specializing attorney
on IRS matters.

Suggestions from group:

1. Contact more BPs to support this effort whatever ^{their station} in life now.
2. How can folks feel good bout giving # to this?
3. Community Funding Board made up of BPs to decide on
use of \$, but no BP to handle it directly. Let NSF
(in re: #2 above). To see if NSF is favorable.

(North Star Fund: rich white folks of inherited \$; charitable;
funds to community based organization)

Consensus: group members will never actually touch a dime of
the \$. See if NSF is favorable.
