The following is an outline of a proposal submitted by Ahadi Tyhimbe (L.A. NAWO) to New York NAWO, for our consideration.

A. The L.A. chapter of NAWO suggest that a mini national conference with select individuals be held with the following objectives:

1. identification of regional cadre that will will develop an ideological analysis for the need for NAWO, and its relationship to the Black Liberation Movement.
2. Development of short and long range goals and objectives
3. The outlining of local and national projects, keeping in mind that they might overlap.
4. Identifying a national conference headquarters, that will deal with the actual pulling together of a national conference.
5. Selection of personnel to be responsible for the conference.
6. National conference of NAWO personnel
7. The call for a broad New Afrikan Women's conference.
