



"For example, an employee within the organization was in contention, and was told to apply, but they brought in a white person with less experience. As Shirley Gooding, secretary of the Department of Labor and Employment Security, says,, sensitivity and commitment have to come from the top.

"We strongly urge the removal of any agency head who lacks sensitivity and commitment to achieve cultural diversity and management," he said.

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## LEGAL NOTICE

Pursuant to Florida Legislature CS/HB 591

## ROSEWOOD

African-American families who can demonstrate real and personal property damages resulting from the destruction of Rosewood, Florida, in 1923, or any African-American resident from Rosewood, who was living on May 5, 1994, and who was present and affected by the violence that took place at Rosewood, and was evacuated the week of January 1, 1923, may file a claim for compensation with the Office of the Attorney General. All claims must be submitted by December 31, 1994. Failure to comply with the December 31, 1994 deadline shall preclude eligible individuals from receiving compensation.

## CLAIMS

All claims must be made by mailing your full legal name, social security number, date of birth, current address, and phone number to the attention of: Gregory Durden, Chief of Civil Rights, Office of the Attorney General, 4000 Hollywood Blvd. Suite 505 S., Hollywood, FL 33021. Claimants are advised that proof of eligibility and proof of the extent of their damages will be requested and required at a later date. Final eligibility will be determined by the Office of the Attorney General in accordance with CS/HB 591. Any person or persons who willingly submit a claim that they know to be false or who prepares fraudulent documents in furtherance of their claim in an attempt to defraud will be prosecuted and may be subject to fines and/or a period of imprisonment.
