- 4. Defendants should submit their factual contentions and legal contentions for purposes of incorporation into a pretrial order by February 10, 1986.

- 5. Responses to the proposed submissions for the pretrial order should be made within 10 days of the submissions.
- 6. Dispositive motions should be filed by March 3, 1986. If the information needed for the resolution of dispositive motions is already available to the parties, the court would urge that the motions be filed prior to the deadline of March 3, 1986.
