LASALLE D. LEFALL, JR.

Dr. LaSalle Lefall acquired his premedical education at Florida A and M University from which he was graduated in 1948. with the B. S. degree.

He earned the M. D. degree from the Howard University College of Medicine, Washington, D. C. in 1952, after which he interned at the Homer G. Phillips Hospital, St. Louis, Mo. from 1952-1953. There followed an assistant residency in surgery at Freedmen's Hospital, Washington, D. C. in 1953-54 and 1955-56; assistant residency in surgery at District of Columbia General Hospital, Washington, 1956-57; senior residency in surgery at Freedmen's Hospital, 1956-57, and senior fellowship in cancer surgery, Memorial-Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, New York, 1957-59. He served as chief of the General Surgical Section, U. S. Army Hospital, Munich, Germany during 1960-61.

Dr. Lefall is currently assistant dean and professor of surgery of the Howard University College of Medicine. Lefall has been the recipient of many brilliant honors and affiliations. Some of these include the presidency of Kappa Pi Honorary Society, the Charles R. Drew Fundamental Forum Award, diplomate of the American Board of Surgery, fellow of the American College of Surgeons and member of the Society of Head and Neck Surgeons. In 1964 he was named one of the "Outstanding Young Men of the Year" by the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce.

A prolific contributor to publications of professional journals in his field of interest, Dr. Lefall is also a member of the Professional Education Committee, Board of Trustees, D. C. Division, American Cancer Society.

JOSEPH KERSHAW

Mr. Joseph Kershaw, a teacher in the Dade County School System joins the law makers of Florida when the Legislature opens in early April. Kershaw swept the Hall of the Capital as a student at FAMCee. His return as a legislator marks the first time a Black man has been a law maker in Florida since reconstruction. Kershaw won by 60,000 votes in a county that had only 57,000 Negro voters.
