THE NORTHERN MOST OPTIONAL ATTENDANCE AREA INCLUDED THE ATTENDANCE AREA OF THE OAKLAND, ^{AND PORTIONS OF THE} STATE STREET & LAFAYETTE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS ALL OF WHICH WERE WHITE SCHOOLS.

THE NORTHERN MOST OPTIONAL ATTENDANCE AREA INCLUDED THE ENTIRE ATTENDANCE AREA OF THE OAKLAND (LUNDGREN) ELEM. SCHOOL AND PORTIONS OF THE STATE STREET AND LAFAYETTE ELEM. SCHOOLS.

ALL THREE OF THOSE SCHOOLS WERE DE FACTO WHITE SCHOOLS IN 1954 AND THE U.S. CENSUS FOR 1960 SHOWS THAT THOSE PORTIONS OF THE STATE STREET & LAFAYETTE ^{AND PORTIONS OF THE} ATTENDANCE ZONES INCLUDED IN THE OPTION ^{HAD RESIDENTIAL} POPULATIONS THAT WERE OR PREDOMINANTLY ALL WHITE. ~~ESSENTIALLY~~ ^{WERE ALL}

THE SOUTHERN MOST OPTION INVOLVED PORTIONS OF THE AVONDALE WEST AND AVONDALE SOUTHWEST ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AREAS AND THOSE AREAS OF THE SCHOOL SYSTEM WERE ALSO SHOWN BY 1960 U.S. CENSUS TO BE ALL OR NEARLY ALL WHITE IN RESIDENTIAL POPULATION.

SEVEN YEARS LATER IN 1966 THOSE TWO ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS WERE RATHERLY IDENTIFIABLE AS WHITE WITH STUDENT RACIAL COMPOSITIONS OF 1.3% MIN. AND 0.7% MIN. RESPECTIVELY WHEN THE SYSTEM WAS 16% MIN AT THE ELEMENTARY LEVEL.

BY AS LATE AS 1976 80% OF THE STUDENTS RESIDING IN THE OPTIONAL AREA WERE WHITE AND OF THOSE 80% WERE EXCEPTING THE HIGHLAND PK. S.H.S.

2. THE U.S. D 501 BUILTON CAUSED TO BE BUILT 10 ADDITIONS TO 10 SCHOOL BUILDINGS BETWEEN THE YEARS 1970 AND 1979.
- A. TWO OF THE ADDITIONS WERE ONE EACH TO THE HIGHLAND PARK S.U.S. AND THE TOPKA WEST S.U.S. AND THOSE ADDITIONS CONTINUED THE PATTERN OF RACIAL CONSTRUCTION AT THESE RACIALLY DISPARATE SCHOOLS BEGUN IN THE SIXTIES.

IN 1971 HIGHLAND PARK S.U.S. STILL CONTAINED 188 BLACK STUDENTS WHILE TOPKA WEST S.U.S. HAD BUT 1.
