They will be found wherever you decide to look. They are niggers from every walk of life. You can look for us in your Harlems, bed-stuys, watts, and all places in between. Look for us in your white house, drinking wine on street corners, partying and working on your pretty bourgeoisie jobs.

As guerillas, we will fight on our own terms wherever conditions are favorable.

Let Mr. Murphy reveal to the People the truth about the two cops killed in the East Village. Let him tell the People that these individuals was accepting graft to continually let drugs run free in our communities. Black People will not sit idly by and continue to see their children die at the hands of America, s sweet words of law and order.

It has been said by Deputy Commissioner Robert Daley, "The Black Liberation Army is deliberately hunting Black Policeman as murder targets." This is an out-right lie to further divide the Black Community. It is the oldest tool of slavery-"Divide and Conquer".
