

Proposals for Reopening FAMU

1. Meeting with a committee composed of elected and invited members of the student body.
 - a. Rep. of the Student Government Association, Chief officers of Campus organizations, Student Resident counselors, Off-campus student representatives, and other opinion shapers.
2. A telegram will be sent to said students inviting them to return for meeting, and contact will be made with students here in the city.
Sunday
3. Meeting will be held at 4:00 p. m./in the Embassy Room.
 - a. This meeting will be followed by dinner.
4. Members from the present committee drafting this proposal should meet with students, plus elected representatives, if necessary, not to exceed six.
5. The faculty draft will be passed out and discussion with the students should follow. It is hoped that the students will disseminate information about the administration-faculty attitude to other students and perhaps, issue a statement of support for improving the University.
6. It is also hoped that the students will work out plans for disseminating the faculty statement and their statement to the general student body during the first meeting.
7. All student activities and facilities should be open for all students on Sunday evening--Bowling alley, swimming pool, card room, etc.
8. It is hoped that once school has begun, the faculty and administration should work on a way to keep dialogue between all factions of students on the campus, regardless of their
