Any prisoner ~~under the circumstances~~ knows that anyone who has the will to struggle - can be much more effective in the streets than they can in prison. So i'm saying that ~~if~~ you should not voluntarily risk going to trial (and probable imprisonment) when you can stay on the streets - without sacrificing principle. you have the will to struggle so you should stay on the streets where you can struggle most effectively. That's why Assata (and all comrades want to) broke out of prison.
