This does not mean that you are not worth this, for your true value for appearances should be the highest paid to any speaker anywhere in the world, but my budget would not allow it. So, I'm forced to acknowledge that the beautiful Mrs. King will not be with us on November 12, 1972.

I was very proud of the way you responded to the television technicians questioning you on NBC at the Democratic Convention.

I can understand the tremendous responsibility that is yours as the chief money raiser for the foundation.

May God continue to bless and keep you.
