3. Describe by year and by race participants in the CETA, Head Start and Follow Through programs. Which school was each program housed for each respective year?

ANSWER:

The Follow Through program was discontinued in the summer of 1981 with very short notice coming from the federal government in regard to the termination of the program. Therefore, there is no further update material on Follow Through, as the program was

cancelled beginning with the 1981-82 school year. There is no change in the answer originally served on March 30, 1982 with regard to the CETA program, except to note that as of the summer of 1984 the CETA program has been discontinued.

The Head Start program continues to be housed at the Polk Child Development Center, the location of all Head Start class-rooms since the beginning of the 1979-80 school year. To supplement the original answer, set forth below is a breakdown by race of the student participants in the Head Start program for the 1982-83 and 1983-84 school years.
