 - 3. Number and type of other facilities in the school including but not limited to science laboratories, libraries, gymnasiums, auditoriums and workshops
 - 4. Outdoor recreational facilities, such as tennis courts, football fields, etc.
- e. Date of closing
- g. Student capacity
- o. Identify for each closed school all documents and memoranda utilized by the Defendant as a basis for justifying such closing. State the location and custodian of each such document or memoranda listed

- s. Whether since the original construction, any additional classrooms or other facilities have been constructed to the schools. If the answer is in the affirmative, state:
1. The date of construction
 2. The type and description of the addition
 3. The cost of construction of the addition and the amount of funds from each source used in the construction
 4. The number of students the facility and the addition were designed to accommodate and the increase in student capacity with the facility addition
 5. How much additional space was obtained by construction of the addition, and what was the space utilized for
 6. Whether the additional capacity was needed to accommodate students transferred from other schools
 7. Whether the additional facility was needed to accommodate an increase in enrollment in the school due to increase in student population within the attendance zone for the school
 8. State any other reasons for the construction of the additional facilities
- t. Whether portable classrooms have been used by the schools. If the answer is affirmative, state:
1. The total number of portable classrooms that have been used by the school
 2. The date the portable classrooms were installed at the school site
 3. The period of time the portable classrooms were in use
 4. The number of students accommodated by each portable classroom and the increase in student capacity with the portable classrooms
 5. Whether the portable classrooms were utilized to accommodate students which were reassigned from other schools. If the answer is affirmative, state the schools from which the students were reassigned
 6. Whether the portable classrooms were utilized to accommodate an increase in enrollment of the school due to an increase in the student population in the attendance area for the school
 7. Please state any other reasons for the use of the portable classrooms

ANSWER:

Attached hereto is the response of Unified School District No. 501 to subparts a-e, g, o, s & t of Interrogatory No. 9, which was prepared under the direction and supervision of Michael D. Tribbey, General Director of Planning and Evaluation Services, with the assistance of Ted Clark, Director of Facilities Planning/Transportation; Gerald Miller, Director of Demographic Services; Debi Smith, Secretary, Planning and Evaluation

Services; Donna Hayek, Secretary, Facilities Planning/Transportation; and Kay Oliver, Secretary.

Attachment A contains the information requested by subparts a, b, c, d 1, and e of Interrogatory No. 9.

Attachment B contains the available information requested by subparts d 2-3 relative to number and sizes of classrooms for schools in operation since, and beginning with, the 1950-51 school year. The information contained in Attachment B is for two school years, 1980-81 (blue) and 1974-75 (yellow).

Attachment C contains the information requested by subpart d 4 for the secondary schools of U.S.D. No. 501. Outdoor recreational facilities for the District's elementary schools are not itemized, since they all have, or had, playing fields for physical education activities and recess, baseball backstops for softball, and various types of playground equipment.

The information requested by subpart g, student capacities for schools currently in operation (1980-81 school year), is contained in Attachment D. The capacities provided are termed "estimated instructional capacities" or EICs -- they are not maximum capacities -- and are based generally on 24 students or fewer per regular classroom space at the elementary and middle school levels and 25 students are fewer per regular classroom space at the high school level. Capacities for schools not currently in operation, and for schools currently in operation for prior years, may be found in the documents submitted in response to Interrogatories 19, 20 and 24. Caution should be exercised in attempting to compare the current EIC of a school for previous years with the capacity indicated in those documents for the following reasons:

1. One or more additions to the facility(ies) may have been constructed during the interim.
2. The interior space of a facility may have been changed. In the past several years an attempt has been made to provide small instructional spaces in all schools for counseling, special education, special reading, and other individual or small group activities, which would reduce the overall capacity of the facility for the regular instructional program.

3. It was common in the fifties, sixties, and even early seventies to use 30 students per regular classroom to determine the capacity of a facility. A capacity calculated in such a way would now imply a "maximum capacity" rather than an "effective instructional capacity."
4. Capacities are now based primarily on the instructional program currently operating in a facility rather than just on the interior space of a facility.

In response to subpart o, the following schools have been closed as regular attendance center since the 1950-51 school year: (a) Boswell, Capper, Crane, Curtis, East Topeka, Highland Park, Holliday, and Roosevelt junior high schools and (b) Buchanan, Central Park, Clay, Grant, Lincoln, McKinley, Monroe, Parkdale, Pierce, Polk, Sheldon, Van Buren, and Washington elementary schools. Specific dates of closing are set forth in response to Interrogatory No. 9e eithin Attachment A.

For all schools closed prior to 1958 all records of materials and/or criteria used as a basis for justifying the school's closing are found in official Board of Education minutes. Official minutes are maintained by the Clerk of the Board at the Topeka Public Schools Administrative Center, 624 S.W. 24th Street, Topeka, Kansas.

For all schools closed since 1958 all records of materials and/or criteria used as a basis for justifying the school's closing are found in official Board of Education Minutes and/or one or more of the following documents:

Copies of the preceding documents have been provided in response to Interrogatory Nos. 19, 20 and 24. The original documents are maintained in the Topeka Public Schools Planning and Evaluation Services office located in the Topeka Public Schools Administrative Center. As indicated previously, official Board of Education minutes are maintained by the Clerk of the Board of the Administrative Center.

Attachment E contains the information requested by subparts s 1-3 and 5. In general, using current capacity criteria, the addition of a regular classroom at the elementary or middle school levels provides effective instructional space for an additional 24 students--25 students at the high school level.

The information requested by subparts t 1-3 is provided in Attachment F. In response to subpart t 4, using currently used facility capacity criteria for an effective instructional program, the typical portable classroom will accommodate 24 students at the elementary and middle school levels and 25

students at the high school level. The estimated instructional capacity of a school would, therefore, increase by 24 students per portable classroom at elementary and middle school levels and 25 students per portable classroom at the high school level.

In response to subparts s 6-8 and t 5-7, both additions and portable classrooms have been provided for the following reasons:

1. To accomodate either an expected or unexpected increase in student population of the attendance area serving the school.
2. To accommodate changes in the educational/instructional program such as the addition of special education, music, counseling, etc.
3. To replace, either permanently or temporarily, facilities destroyed by natural or man-made causes.
4. To accommodate additional students from changes in school attendance areas such as when schools are closed. (For additions only--portable classrooms are not normally provided to a school to accommodate additional students from a closed school).

It is difficult, if not impossible, to determine with any definitiveness which of these reasons was responsible for a specific addition to a facility or the placement of a specific portable classroom. In general, portable classrooms are only used for emergency situations, and additions are constructed when the enrollment of a school is projected to be stable and an addition is needed for an improved instructional program, or continuing increases in enrollment are expected, and no adjustments in attendance area boundaries for the school are feasible.
