





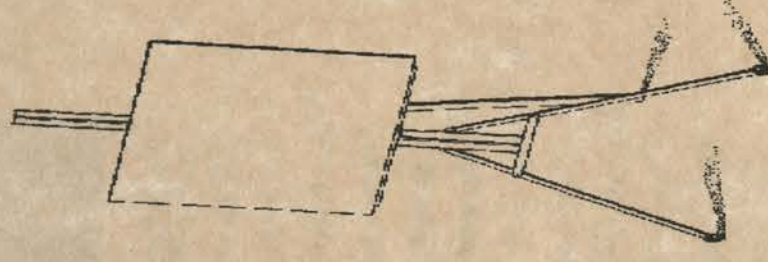
Philosophy of Art
