



LONG WANDERING MASS TOGETHERNESS — It was almost two years ago that thousands of Americans, united by sorrow from a disparate array of beliefs and backgrounds, marched in Atlanta around and behind the mule-drawn wagon bearing the body of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Tuesday, at 8 p.m., at the Chief Theater, a 2½-hour documentary — “KING: a Filmed Record . . . Montgomery to Memphis” — will be shown, once.
