Per our conversation this morning by telephone, I am enclosing the information as promised. I would like to cite that FAMU is, by virtue of the 1890 Statue, designated as a land-grant institution and FSU is not; yet, they have a department of Home Economics and is admitted to the National Association of Land-Grant Colleges and State Universities. We do not intend to lose our land-grant status. If there are congressional plans, as I understand there are some rumors to repeal the 1890 law, then I along with some some others would press for a repeal of the 1862 law.
