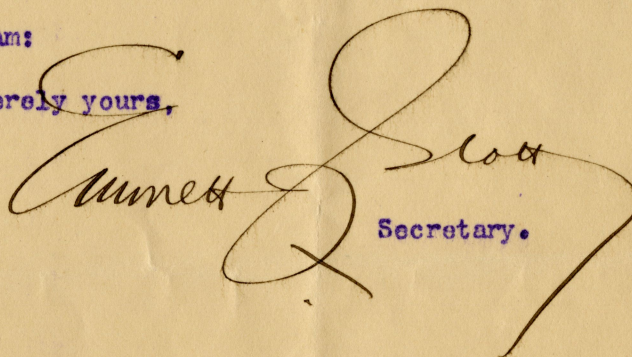
Dear Prof. Work:
