- 1. The board of education (or school board or board of trustees) of the

 Superintendent of Public Instruction for the establishment of a unified school district comprised as described in this petition and in accordance with law.

Also attached to this petition is a diagram showing the following: County boundaries, boundaries of each petitioning district, proposed unified school district boundaries, non-high school territory boundaries, and the boundaries of any other territory which is in the proposed unified district, including a specification of the amount of such other territory and the name of any school district offering at least grades 10 to 12 in which such "other territory" is located. Also attached to this petition is the legal description of territory of the proposed unified district which is not a part of any of the petitioning school districts (divide this description between non-high school territory and territory of districts offering at least grades 10 to 12.). Each of the attachments to this petition referred to in this paragraph is hereby made a part of this petition.

- 5. None of the area of the within proposed unified district is included in any other unified school district which has heretofore been established or organized as a unified school district under the school unification acts.
- 6. The unified school district proposed to be established by this petition complies with the requirement of subsection (c) of section 11 of the first unification act (K.S.A. 72-6744(c)) for the following reason:

The School District named in this petition for a unified district, will have an expected enrollment of 22,783 students, one (1) through twelve (12), on September 15, 1966. Estimated Tangible Valuation of the School District No. 23 of Shawnee County, Kansas is \$148,800,000.00.(1965)

- 7. Careful consideration has been given to the grade and curriculum requirements of K.S.A. 72-6755, as amended by section 16 of the third unification act.

 This petitioning school board has carefully considered the "Kansas Secondary School Handbook of 1961" established by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- 8. It is the opinion of the petitioning board that in the proposed unified district it will be practicable to offer and teach at least thirty (30) approved units of instruction in grades nine (9) through twelve (12). It is understood by the petitioning board that such thirty (30) approved units of instruction in grades nine (9) through twelve (12) must be in compliance with the standards for approval thereof established by the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.
- (a) With respect to the proposed unified district the following statements are made:
 - (1) The proposed unified district will have an expected enrollment on September 15, 1966, in grades nine (9) through twelve (12) of 6437 students.
 - (2) The proposed unified district will have the following buildings and facilities available for use of grades nine (9) through twelve (12): 11 Junior High School buildings (grades 7-0)

 3 Senior High School buildings (grades 10-12)
 - (3) The proposed unified district will be able to operate 3 Senior high school(s). The smallest high school of this unified district will have an enrollment of 1100 students on September 15, 1966.
 - (4) Designate which high school buildings each high school will use if more than one high school is to be located in the unified district.
