1.We demand freedom. We claim the right to determine the destiny

of our schools.

We believe that students are the people who suffer or benefit from the way schools are run. Without a student democratic government to protect and represent the student rights we are not free in the schools to get a decent education. Students must be heard and heeded if education is to become relevant. This is an education that will affect and determine the liberation of our people.

- 2. We demand full enrollment in the schools for the people. We believe the government is responsible and obligated to give every man a decent education.
- 3. We demand free transportation for all the students. We believe students shouldn't be deprived of an education because adequate funds cannot be obtained.
- 4. We demand decent educational facilities fit for the use of the students.

We believe that the schools should be placed in the hands of the community with financial aid from the government, so the community can develope a decent educational system.

5. We demand an end to administrative harassment and brutality of students.

We believe all white racists teachers should be excluded and restricted from all schools. Such teachers are not interested in the welfare and development of students.

6. We demand food programs for the students of all schools run by the

community.

We believe that were entitled to free breakfast and/or lunch with food fit for the consumption of human beings. Parents should be hired as dieticians to determine our meals.

7. We demand an immediate end to police brutality.
We believe that the police are used to impede the students progress in education. If schools are to become more functional, police should be excluded and restricted from school premisses. We have the right to preserve our life and liberty by any means necessary.

8. We demand education that teaches us our true history and our role

in the present-day society.

We believe if a person does not have knowledge of himself and postion in society and the world, then he has little chance to relate to anything else.

9. We demand that all students that have been expelled or suspended be reinstated.

We believe that students don't receive impartial judgment or have been put out because of incidents outside of the schools jurisdiction.

10. We demand all students brought to trial be tried by a jury of their peer.

We believe that the students courts should follow the U.S.Constitu tion. The 14th Amendment gives a person the right to be tried by a jury of his peer. The jury would have to be selected from the students. We have been tried by white administrators, who doesn't have the understanding of the "average reasoning person of the non-white community.
