The original 70 imates were shipped out, according to the PROD source, late on the day of the stoppage. This job action was said to have been peaceful.

The PROD source said after the transfer that the inmates were placed in a 24hour lock-up and stripped of much of their clothing. They also were denied toiletries and medication and had been kept isolated until the day of the court action.

Attorneys for the inmates are expecting an early court date.
