Holland to Speak At Dedication

Governor Spessard L. Holland will deliver the principal address at Florida A and M college Sunday at 4 o'clock when the administration building is formally dedicated J R E Lee Hall in memory of the late president.

The building, erected in 1927 at a cost of \$300,000, houses administrative offices, classrooms, music rooms and the college auditorium seating 1,500 persons.

Dr. William H. Gray, jr., who succeeded Dr. Lee as the college's president, will preside at the dedication services. H. P. Adams, chairman of the state board of control, will make the presentation, and Lawrence A. Hicks, of the department of agriculture, will present the Lee memorial chimera.
