The Condition of the above obligation is such that Whereas the above bounden James L. Paythief Adm^r as aforesaid hath this day made application to the Court of the County of Gadsden for an order the following property belonging to the Estate of the said Titus Farr Dec^r viz one Negro Woman named Melley, and the following tracts of Land viz the E¹/₂ of the So. W¹/₄ of Section 23 Township 2 N of R. 3 W¹/₄ which order has this day been granted by the Judge aforesaid.

Now if the above bounden James L. Paythief Administrator as aforesaid shall well and truly acct^r for the proceeds of said sale according to Law then the above obligation to be null and void otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue.
