

DR. WORK, AUTHOR OF NEGRO YEAR BOOK, IS BURIED AT TUSKEGEE

TUSKEGEE, Ala.—Dr. Monroe N. Work, Director Emeritus of the Department of Records and Research, eminent scholar and bibliographer, who died here Wednesday night following an illness of several weeks, was buried Friday. Dr. Work joined the Tuskegee Institute faculty in 1908 and organized the Department of Records and Research and became widely known for his scholarly contributions to various publications. He was a graduate of the Chicago Theological Seminary and the University of Chicago. In 1942 he received the Alumni Association Citation in recognition of 40 years of public service.
